

Report on workshop on Teaching Law, Reading Research & Review

Government New Law College, Indore has been organizing Workshop on Legal Research, Teaching Methods & Techniques from 04th February to 11th February 2021.

Fourth day of the workshop on 8th February 2021 began with the introduction of the event followed by the brief description of our institution. Further, Prof. Jatin Verma Sir took the floor to introduce the Guest speaker Dr. Uday Pratap Singh, NLU, Bhopal, for delivering a lecture on Non- doctrinal research in Law.

Honourable speaker in his address enumerated the indispensable ingredients of non doctrinal research. He also put numerous key steps to carry out the same in more effective manner. While addressing, he mentioned few of the examples of the work he carried out during his own research like women welfare, local institutions, functional classification based on caste & so on. Moreover, he emphasized the importance of non doctrinal research in law making for its effectiveness. Mentioning this, he also discussed about questionnaires, interviews schedules & difficulties that comes while carrying out the non doctrinal research specifically. While concluding the session, he categorically advised academicians to take on the research project specifically non doctrinal.

Following the 1st session, Prof. Firoz Ahmad Mir Sir invited the next guest speaker Dr. Archana Ranka, HOD, School of Law, DAVV Indore for the lecture on 'Academic Integrity'. Ma'am at the outset, explained the very concept of 'Academic Integrity' followed by the certain rules as to the plagiarism in research field, rendered by the University Grant Commission itself. Furthermore, he enumerated multiple kinds of 'Academic Misconduct' including fabrication, falsification, impersonation etc. Besides this, she took note of the UGC guidelines and International standards regarding the same. While concluding, she underpinned the need of Artificial Intelligence so as to maintain the Academic Integrity.

At the end of the workshop, vote of thanks was delivered by Prof. Jyoti Sharma Ma'am & with this, session was concluded. The workshop was streamed on YouTube live where about 50 participants joined and on CISCO Webex portal where about 70 participants joined the program.
